
Higher Ground is an inspiring coming-of-age tale of resilience, courage and spirit that illuminates how life can be beautiful even in the darkest of times.

His publishing clients include New Frontier Publishing, Walker Books, Candlewick Press and Scholastic Press. Working predominantly with watercolour and graphite, Tull's books have been featured in *The Sydney Morning Herald* and *The New York Times* and on ABC's Mornings radio and *Play School* on ABC Kids. Some of his books were included among the Notables list as part of The Children's Book Council of Australia Awards and shortlisted for Speech Pathology Australia Book of the Year Awards and Crystal Kites Awards. Along with his bookmaking, Tull is an art teacher and uses his experience in visual arts and storytelling to promote creative expression for people of all ages. EDUCATIONAL APPLICABILITY

Higher Ground is a wonderful starting point for exploring themes of resilience, strength in the face of adversity and sustainability. The story teaches readers the importance of family values, independence and life lessons. The book combines elements of a graphic novel with illustrated picture book and diary, making it an innovative reading experience. The use of sparse text and prose not only captures the mood and tone of the narrative but also aids readers with learning difficulties. The illustrations were done using a combination of watercolour, graphite powder, gouache and acrylic paints. The cover of the book was put together using traditional methods of paper and mixed media images.






SUSTAINABILITY ACTIVITIES
